Open Action Items: combine #80 and #94, Drew working on council presentation, there is little to no attendance at neighborhood meetings with no feedback

#82 Chip reported no usable art from the locker company,
Harry moved & Drew seconds to pay Stick Company to do art for bike lockers (unanimous approval)

#93, #98 & #99 combined, Harry will take the lead in the bike rodeo event for next May bike month

#96 Frank, Jing, and Chip met to work on bike routes, TAP grants to be handled by the city (closed)

Ripe Banannas: Jonathan noted that there are possibly lights to be given away, it was discussed to contact Morgantown Healthright and Christian Help to target low income folks who might be using their bicycles for transportation to get to work

Bike Network Update/Tap Grant Project: discussion over maps ensued and the following three options seemed most popular: Vaike Hass trail by Suncrest Elementary, Trail following bench below the PRT from the maintenance facility along Mon Blvd to the Arboretum, the 705 cow tunnel connector from the experimental farm to the 705 multi use path, Drew will send out summaries of the projects for the board to review.

New Action Items: Chip print year update stickers for the Bike friendly signs, Chip & Drew install the stickers, Chip meet with Dana on Bike Rings, Bridgette write letter to non profits serving low income folks about distributing lights, Drew will summarize projects and them to the board, Bike Board members will read Drew's summaries and prioritize the projects in order of importance
