Code Enforcement Hosts Tenant and Landlord Conference

MORGANTOWN – Whether you’re planning a new home improvement project or just trying to figure out where to put your trash can when it’s not garbage day, it’s important to know your responsibilities as a homeowner or renter.

Morgantown Code Enforcement is hosting a conference for all landlords and tenants, students or otherwise, to learn about codes and ordinances within city limits.

Code Enforcement Officers will be in City Council Chambers on Wednesday, September 13 at 1:30 p.m. to discuss property maintenance, trash ordinances, sidewalk upkeep, and much more. Officials from the Morgantown police and fire departments will also host a question and answer session with attendees.

Officers are hoping that both full-time residents who own property or rent within the city and West Virginia University students who are living in Morgantown for the school year will attend.

Participants will be able to learn about, and hopefully avoid, the citations that come along with violations to the codes and ordinances the City of Morgantown has in effect.
