WVDOH Project Updates

As reported by Bill Austin, MMMPO, on 05/25/2021 [edited by staff engineer Drew Gatlin]

University Avenue / Collins Ferry Road Intersection Improvement

- This project involves the reconstruction of this intersection into a roundabout.
- There have been two properties in dispute slowing progress on this project.
 - WVDOH has been granted access to one property.
 - There will be a legal (non-public) hearing on 6/14 for the other property.

Van Voorhis Road Improvement from Burroughs Street to West Run Road

- This project involves lane widening / standardization, sidewalk construction, and shoulder construction.
- WVDOH has requested titles for acquired rights-of-way.
- WVDOH expects construction to begin in 2023.

West Run Road Widening from Stewartstown Road to Point Marion Road

- This project includes lane widening, shoulder construction, and intersection redesign (at Point Marion Road)
- WVDOH has acquired 99% of necessary rights-of-way.
- WVDOH currently resolving an issue with FAA.

Beechurst Avenue Spot Improvement Projects b/t Fayette Street and Campus Drive

- City and WVU are finalizing a land swap at Campus Drive / McLane Avenue.
- City, WVU, and WVDOH are finalizing discussions on Campus / Beechurst intersection abd wall design.
- WVDOH expects construction to begin Spring 2022.

Mileground Road Expansion

- WVDOH is still acquiring rights-of-way.
- WVDOH has granted notices to proceed on limited utility relocations.

Greenbag Road Improvements

- WVDOH expects a "Finding of No Significant Impacts" (FONSI) from FHWA imminently.
- Recommended project is consistent with the environmental assessment on WVDOH website.
